The Gochman Family Collection consists of a private lending collection of contemporary art focusing on work by Indigenous and American artists. A guiding principle of the collection is to support living artists with the intent to direct resources and power to those building a future through an Indigenous lens. The collection often highlights artwork that is anti-colonial and Indigenous-centered. Beyond acquiring works of art, the Gochman Family Collection team works extensively to support and promote Indigenous leadership in the arts and beyond. The curatorial associate will work closely with a small team to shape the future of the Gochman Family Collection. Some of the duties include:

- Host tours of the Collection in New York, South Florida, and Colorado
- Represent the Collection at various exhibitions and public events
- Support the curatorial staff and collection manager in coordinating loans, installations, and production.
- Organize and implement education-based public programming around the Collection
- Maintain database of contacts mailing list, create social media posts
- Collect and organize archival material in relation to the artworks, Collection, and artists
- Collaborate on Collection-related publications.
- Research, interview artists, and create short texts on the works in the Collection
- Various other responsibilities TBD based on Collection initiatives

The ideal candidate will be able to travel frequently (travel expenses will be reimbursed) and have a working knowledge of Contemporary Indigenous art.
